



Do not tighten hardware completely unless noted. Keep all stock hardware removed from machine.

- 1. Raise *front* of machine off ground, secure on jack stands, and remove Wheels.
- 2. Remove lower Shocks from factory mount.
- 3. Install Front Brackets (A) with M10-1.5 x 60mm Lg. HHCS (B), Spacers (E), M10 Flat Washers (C), and M10-1.5 Nylock Nuts (D). See Figs. 1 1a.
- 4. Reinstall Shocks to Front Brackets (A) with stock hardware. See Figs. 1 1a.
- 5. Tighten all hardware completey and reinstall Wheels.
- 6. Raise *rear* of machine off ground and secure with jack stands.
- Unhook Sway Bar, remove Brake Line Clips, and remove Shocks from Lower A-Arms. Remove Lower A-Arms.
- 8. Transfer Bushings and Zerk Grease Fittings from stock Lower A-Arms to Rear A-Arms (F).
- 9. Install Rear A-Arms (F) to machine with stock hardware. See Figs. 2 2a.
- Use pre-drilled and tapped holes to reinstall Brake Line Clips into Rear A-Arms (F). See Fig. 2a.
- 11. Reinstall Shocks to Rear Brackets (B) with stock hardware. See Fig. 2a.
- 12. Reinstall Sway Bar to Rear Brackets (B). Reuse stock Bushings.
- 13. Tighten all hardware completely and reinstall Wheels.
